DID YOU KNOW?

1. It is widely accepted that poutine was invented in 1957 when a trucker asked Fernand Lachance to add cheese curds to his fries in Warwick, Quebec.
2. "Poutine" is Quebec slang for "a mess."
3. In 1970s New York and New Jersey, poutine was served as a late-night side dish at clubs. They called it "disco fries."
4. The largest poutine in the world was made in Saguenay, Que., and weighed 654 kg—about as much as a large horse.
5. Considered the most expensive poutine in Montreal, the poutine au foie gras is available for \$23 at Au Pied de Cochon
